Patient Information

- Maria Kavalsky
- 20 years old woman
- single, no children, living with 3 room mates
- art student and waitress

Your Role

Primary care physician, seeing patient for the second time

The Scenario

- CC: Follow-up regarding migraine treatment
- First patient visit was 2 months ago when she c/o recurrent headaches. You diagnosed her with migraines and prescribed Imitrex, expecting a positive response.
- Apart from the headaches, the medical history was unremarkable. Family medical history indicated father with cardiovascular problems and several cases of cancer in extended family.
- You vaguely remember that patient grew up in York.

Your Task

Follow up with patient

(instead of performing a physical exam ask facilitator for findings if appropriate)

4 weeks post-attack
Location: Metropolitan City (200 miles from York)
